

TERMINATION TERMS & AGREEMENT

To terminate lessons (temporarily or indefinitely), studio families must give advanced 30-day notice. Your request will remove you from the master schedule; however, your financial responsibility for any remaining tuition of the music year's contract will be evaluated by owner / director. You will be held responsible for the remaining unpaid balance of your *annual tuition fees* unless it is determined that the circumstances surrounding your withdrawal prevent you from maintaining the contract agreement.

Families who do not honor The Musical Express' year-round contract agreement and wish to re-enroll at the studio for the new music year will have to wait until after a 6-months withdrawal period.

If you are uncertain about an annual commitment to piano lessons, we do extend a trial month alternative. If after the first month of piano lessons you wish to withdraw from The Musical Express, you may do so without any fees or penalties.

As owner / director of The Musical Express, Temeka Davis reserves the right to terminate or dismiss any student she determines not to be progressing in The Musical Express' music education / piano lessons program; or if the studio's teaching style / philosophy does not complement the student's learning style or musical goals. Some other actions and / or conduct that could result in dismissal from the studio include (but are not limited to): behavioral problems; destructive force displayed towards teachers and / or studio property; complete disinterest and / or neglect of piano studies; and repeated absenteeism. Temeka Davis will make the final decision in the outcome of such described matters concerning all students enrolled at The Musical Express.
